Rangoli Decoration Competition

Rangoli is drawn in different states with different names and on different themes. Be it Kollam in Tamil Nadu, Sathiya in Gujarat, Alpana in Bengal, Mandana in Rajasthan, Osa in Odisha, Aipan in Uttarakhand, or simply the Rangoli from Maharashtra – every region has its own unique way of representing their traditions, folklore and practices. Now it is your chance to showcase your creative skills by participating in the Rangoli Decoration Competition.

Rules:

- 1. Theme of the competition is restricted to "Diwali Khushiyon Ki".
- 2. Individual participation only.
- **3.** The event will be organised in classroom only.
- **4.** There will be only one round of competition.
- **5.** The participants have to bring their own material.
- 6. The participants will be given 1 hr for decorating rangoli.
- 7. No extra time will be given in any case.
- **8.** Certificates will be awarded to First, Second and Third position holders.

Judging Criteria:

- Overall Appearance and appeal
- Details and Clarity in Rangoli art.
- Color combination.
- Creativity.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED:

- 1. Rangoli should be in the form of circle only.
- **2.** Cut the circle of maximum diameter from an A4 sheet (can be white pastel sheet or coloured pastel sheet).
- 3.Draw the rangoli pattern on the sheet cut-out.
- **4.**Colouring and decoration should be done in the class only.
- **5.**For decoration use only stickers, avoid the use of glue or fevicol.
