Let's try to be independent during this summer break by developing fine motor skills.

Fine motor skill activities are a great help when it comes to develop your writing. These activities focus on motor skill development of small muscle movements, usually involving fingers, thumb, hand and wrist movements.

Here are some activities which can be included in your daily curriculum, which will help you refine your pincer grasp:-

- ! Button up your shirt.
- ! Put on your socks and shoes.
- ! Open and close a zipper lock of your bag.
- ! Tear a chapatti and eat your meal on your own.
- ! Squeeze and relax your hands and enjoy.
- ! Clothesclip. Take some clothesclip, and a box, Squeeze the clips and clip them on the edges of a box on your own.
- ! Nuts and Bolts. Take a larger nut and bolt, use your fingers and wrist, twist the metal nut onto the bolt.
- ! Try to tie your shoe lace.
- ! Take an eyedropper, fill it with colours and squeeze different colours in a bowl.
- ! Dig your hands into clay, use your hand and wrist muscles playing with it.



#### Yummy Oreo Milkshake




A thick milkshake with lots of Oreo cookies!

So, encourage your kids to come up with some innovative and creative ideas.


Below are few examples of how we can reuse toilet and foil rolls to make unique things.







#### **COLOUR BY CODE**

- Water it daily and see it grow into a plant.




Note: Send the above sapling on the day the school will reopen.

#### English:-

<u>Note</u>- Write the date on every page (should be written by the child), and should be done in a separate 4 lines English copy

#### Maths:

- Write the counting from 1 to 50.
- Write backward counting from 20 to 1.
- Starting from counting 1 to 20, make objects as per the number and colour them. **e.g**. for number 1 you can draw Sun, for number 2 you can draw eyes and so on.

<u>Note</u>- Write the date on every page (should be written by the child), and should be done in a separate Maths copy.

#### Hindi:

- Write all the swar neatly and carefully within 5 lines.
- Write one full page each of all the varn till nya, neatly within 5 lines.
- For every swar and varn done till now draw 2 objects and colour them.

<u>Note</u>- Write the date on every page (should be written by the child), and should be done in a separate 5 lines Hindi copy.
